

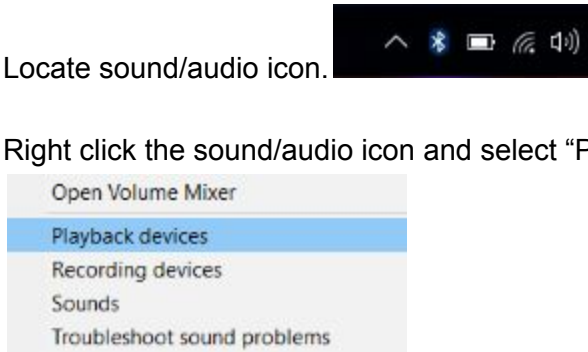
Setting up audio with Bring your own device (BYOD)

Purpose:

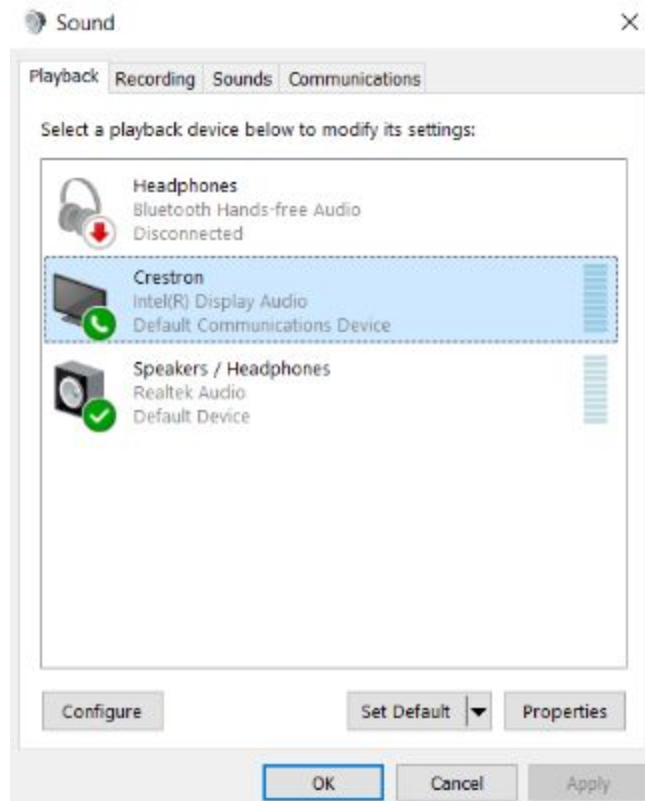
To help you set up or re-establish audio with the system.

Steps for Windows:

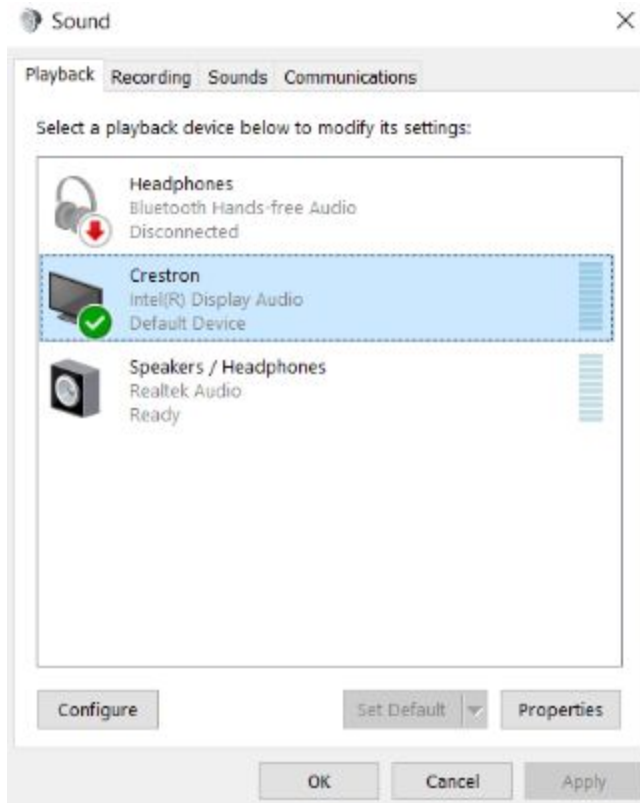
1. Locate sound/audio icon.
2. Right click the sound/audio icon and select "Playback devices".



3. Sound menu should open and an option for "Crestron" will be listed. Highlight it and set to default.



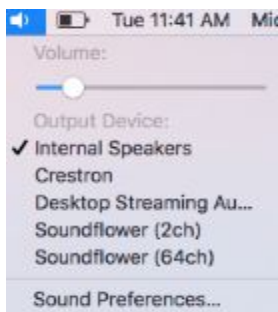
4. Once you've set "Crestron" to default, you are all set and can close the window.



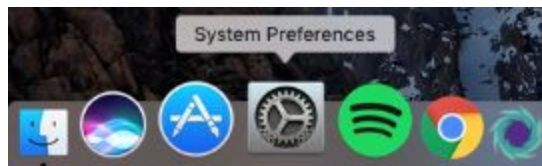
Steps for Mac:

Method 1

1. Locate sound/audio icon. 
2. Right click the sound/audio icon and select "Crestron" and your done.

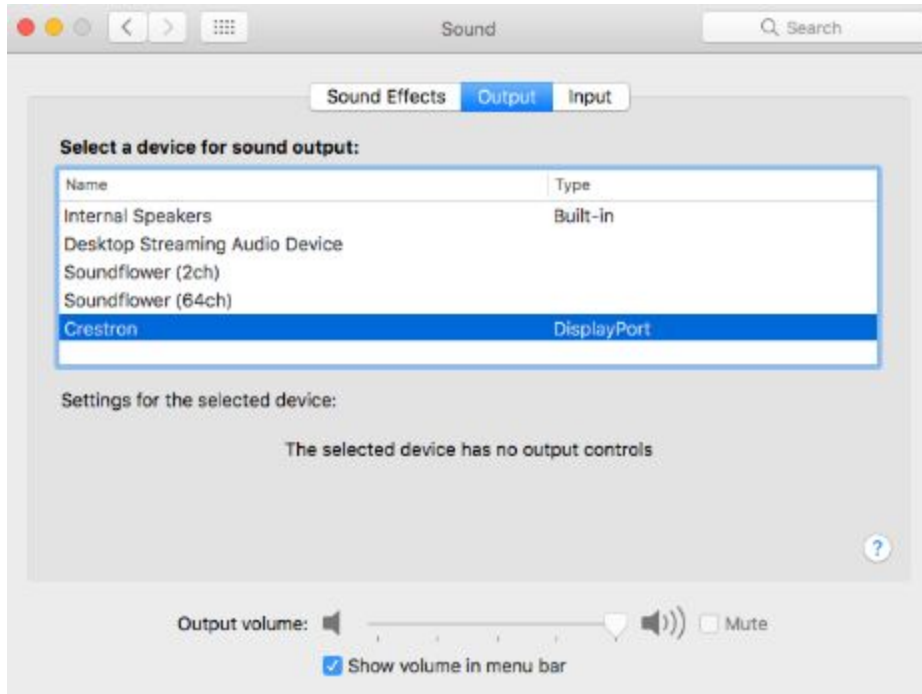


Method 2



1. Go to System Preferences
2. Select the sound icon usually at the end of the second row.
3. Select the "Output" tab

4. Once selected a list of sound outputs should populate select “Crestron” and your audio should be set.
